First Day 2021

Returning Year 11 and 12 students will be able to arrive onsite after **1.00pm on Sunday 31st January 2021** or before **8.00am on Monday 1st February 2021**.

Normal timetable will commence on Monday 1st February 2021.

**Any students that may be bringing a horse to the College may do so on the following times;
Sunday 31st January 2021 between 2.00pm – 5.00pm.**

Equine staff will be available for horse arrival, health checks and equipment checks. Special arrangements will be made for quarantine. Please see additional details for horse agistment and arrival.

No horses will be permitted on site without the correct paperwork and associated checks.

Students may return by a TransWA bus. Parents please contact Residential staff on 9881 9732 between 8am – 3pm from 27th – 29th January 2021 or via email or REACH.

- **Various forms** for students wishing to bring a horse onsite or ride horses recreationally. Students wishing to bring a horse onsite will need to inform the College **by 27th January 2021**.
