## 7. General Business

### A) School Priorities List

The Oval football posts quote of \$2800 was discussed further. There was a consensus that the goal posts would not be funded at this stage. Questions to ask principal included:

- Are the existing goal posts on old oval used by equestrian able to be shifted?
- The school does not have a football team. Will the goal posts be used?
- Are the goal posts a request of students?
- Can we seek sponsorship specifically for goal posts from a business?
- Would hockey goals be more beneficial given the two school hockey teams?

This will be left for decision at the next meeting.

### B) School Ball 2020

Significant discussion about the ball survey results. Majority of those in attendance at the P&C meeting were in favour of holding the school ball locally and at least trialling it for a year. The school board are more inclined to continue to hold the ball in Perth. Date of the ball will need to be decided with the end of term 1 in 2020 being Easter weekend. The parent response to the survey was not significant but the general feel from quite a few families is that the cost is a significant burden on families. Accommodation and hair and makeup venues was considered. Could we compile a list of businesses that can provide these services? Can the P&C organise hair and makeup artists from outer lying towns? Bronwyn, Liz and Renae all volunteered to be on ball committee if needed.
