

Unique Student Identifier (USI)

Students undertaking nationally recognised training are required to have a Unique Student Identifier (USI). This includes nationally recognised training delivered as part of the Vocational Education and Training (VET) in Schools programmes.

This number will be used throughout their life to keep track of any training and qualifications they complete. To obtain the number, parents/guardians must apply for the number on behalf of students. To do this, please go to the following site:

Please make sure you have one form of ID from the list below ready. Examples of acceptable forms of ID:

- Driver's Licence
- Medicare Card
- Australian Passport
- Visa (with Non-Australian Passport) for international students
- Birth Certificate (Australian) *please note a Birth Certificate extract is not sufficient
- Certificate Of Registration By Descent
- Citizenship Certificate
- ImmiCard
