MANDATORY ITEMS:
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Helmet—approved (AUS 3838) (Must be less than 4 years old, include a removable peak and we recommend all helmets to be tagged with an EA Helmet tag).
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Riding gloves
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Body protector (Vipa) (required for jumping and/or track work)

ADDITIONAL PERSONAL ITEMS LIST SPECIFIC TO EQUINE IF AGISTING A HORSE FOR HORSE
Feed bin
2 x padlocks
2 x hay bags
1 x paddock feed bucket
1 x feed bucket to mix and carry feed in
Halter and 2 lead ropes
Dressage whip
Jumping whip
Saddle (all purpose recommended), second saddle optional
Lunge rope & side reins
Splint boots
Bridle
2 saddle cloths
Hard feed (feed lockers can only hold 2 chaff bags, 1 bag of pellets/muesli and a bucket of minerals at a time) No Molasses permitted in feed lockers!
Grooming kit including a water scraper and sponge
Leather oil and rags
2 cotton rugs
2 winter rugs
Fly veil

HORSE FIRST AID KIT:
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• 2 rolls of 75mm adhesive dressing (Elastoplast)
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• 2 rolls of 75mm elastic bandage (Flexi-wrap)
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• 1 pkt of gauze swabs
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• 1 roll of cotton wool
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• 1-2pkts Animal lintex
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Blunt- ended scissors
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Betadine
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Antibiotic Powder eg. Teramycin
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Cetrigen
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Fly repellent
