EXCURSION INFORMATION

As part of the program at the WA College of Agriculture – Narrogin, students participate in a range of activities that are conducted off the College site. These can be divided into three categories

1. DAY TRIPS OF A ROUTINE NATURE JUDGED OF LOW RISK

Trips associated with education, learning, sport, recreation or community service. These trips are conducted within a day or part thereof and typically within the local area, regional centres or Perth. Because they are routinely organised, staff have a good understanding of the environment and the inherent risk which are considered low. As a result, parent permission for these trips is on enrolment.

2. DAY TRIPS WITH AN ELEMENT OF RISK OR OF AN UNUSUAL NATURE

These day trips are not routine or usual or contain a higher element of risk and are not covered by the blanket sign off indicated above. Specific parental permission will be obtained for each occasion with detail on the excursion provided for parents to make an informed decision. This includes any water based activity **NOT** conducted at Narrogin town pool.

3. OVERNIGHT TRIPS AND WORKPLACE LEARNING

Because these excursions are over an extended period or require an overnight stay or have an enhanced level of risk they will require significant specific planning and written parental approval for each occasion.

The following information details the range of excursions that will be conducted on a regular basis and for which your consent is sought for the whole school year.

EDUCATIONAL EXCURSIONS

General Excursions

Location:	Narrogin Town site or within 50km of Narrogin Town site.
Activities:	Community events e.g. ANZAC/Remembrance Day services, events organized at another local DoE site e.g. sporting event at N.S.H.S., P.E. lessons held at one of the local sporting facilities.
Purpose:	Students are provided with the opportunity to represent the College at local community events and participate in sporting or educational activities at another DoE site or town facility.
Transport:	College vehicle
Supervision:	College staff will transport students and will be in attendance. There may be times when students will be unsupervised. However, staff will always be contactable by mobile phone. Students are required to remain in pairs or small groups at all times.
Cost:	Possible entry to venue
