Principal's Report – Mark Pascoe on behalf of Clare Roser</p> <p>Mark thanked all parents involved in the P&C and reiterated the value of parents' involvement and the benefits to students from P&C support.</p> <p>Student numbers for 2023 are looking strong with currently 159 booked (138 in residence which is at capacity).</p> <p>Mark asked for consideration be given to P&C supporting an additional day for chaplain at the college being approximately \$12000.00. Discussion evolved that this will be left as an item for consideration when levies are collected in 2023.</p>
